Enclosed are your 2025 STATE Club Parking Hangtag and Membership Card for new members (Stickers for past members). If you are a new STATE Club Member, we'd like to express a warm welcome to you. As for returning and longtime members, we are encouraging you to continue supporting and helping to set the conditions for building a successful "Championship" caliber athletic program. We reached an historical level of membership in 2024, in which we surpassed 700 members. While we want you to enjoy your game day experiences, it is paramount that you abide by the University's security and safety guidelines and of equal importance, the sanctioned STATE Club Game-zone rules. By doing so, we will have a safe and secure environment. Thank you for your cooperation in these important matters. Go Bulldogs...

This letter provides specific information and updated guidelines in reference to the STATE Club Game-zone parking and tailgating:

- The SCSU Game zone includes the following parking neighborhoods: Felton Field, the Kennel Dog Houses area, Mitchell Field, SHM area, Staley Field, Wilkinson Field, and recently included Mason Field. Your perspective STATE Club Membership level corresponds with a clearly/identifiable assigned color hangtag. Likewise, each parking neighborhood has its' designated parking, amenities, and specific guidelines on potentially tailgating. Always make sure your hangtag is visible.
- Park only in your assigned space. This includes (with no exceptions), your vehicle, trailer, golf cart - all must fit in your outlined parking space. A private security force will supplement the University Police in enforcing parking. Meaning, non-compliance and our violators will be towed. To provide the best customer service, we've added resources/manpower to monitor the Game-zone, ensuring members paid spaces are always made available during gameday.
- Only State Club members are permitted to bring registered golf carts to the Game zone. You must notify the Parking Committee if you plan on adding a registered golf cart or vehicle within your assigned parking space.
- Previous RV parking on SHM has relocated to the Wilkinson Neighborhood.
- The Mitchell Neighborhood is designated the Garnet and Blue or higher-level parking.
- Assigned RV/Camper parking with electrical hook-ups will continue to be provided on Staley, Mitchell, and Wilkinson neighborhoods. Mason Field neighborhood is being transformed to offer Bulldog Car level or higher membership and RV/Camper parking. Note: all Single game-day parking and tailgating will only be permitted in the Pecan Grove Neighborhood.
- **Lost or misplaced hangtags** - can be replaced at a cost of **\$50.00**.
- **Membership contributions to the STATE Club are non-refundable.**
